Evolva is seeking a highly experienced microbial fermentation specialist to lead our Fermentation Group located in Reinach, Switzerland. Our Fermentation Group provides support for our metabolic engineering teams, and is additionally involved in the technology transfer of our production strains and processes to our CMOs.

This position requires a highly, results-oriented individual, who will thrive in a fast-paced environment where priorities will change regularly. The multi-disciplinary nature of the fermentation department requires close interaction with scientists from the strain engineering, downstream process development, and analytical teams, as well as contract manufacturing organizations.

The successful candidate will lead a dedicated team responsible for the characterization of metabolically engineered microbial strains in small-scale fermentation, development and optimization of scalable microbial processes, and technology transfer of developed processes to manufacturing scale at the facilities of our CMO partners. In addition to the development and implementation of process improvements in order to constantly reduce production costs, the team is responsible for providing active support, supervision and trouble-shooting of manufacturing campaigns.

- Managing and coordinating complex experimental schedules across multiple projects
- Rigorous quality control of fermentation experiments
